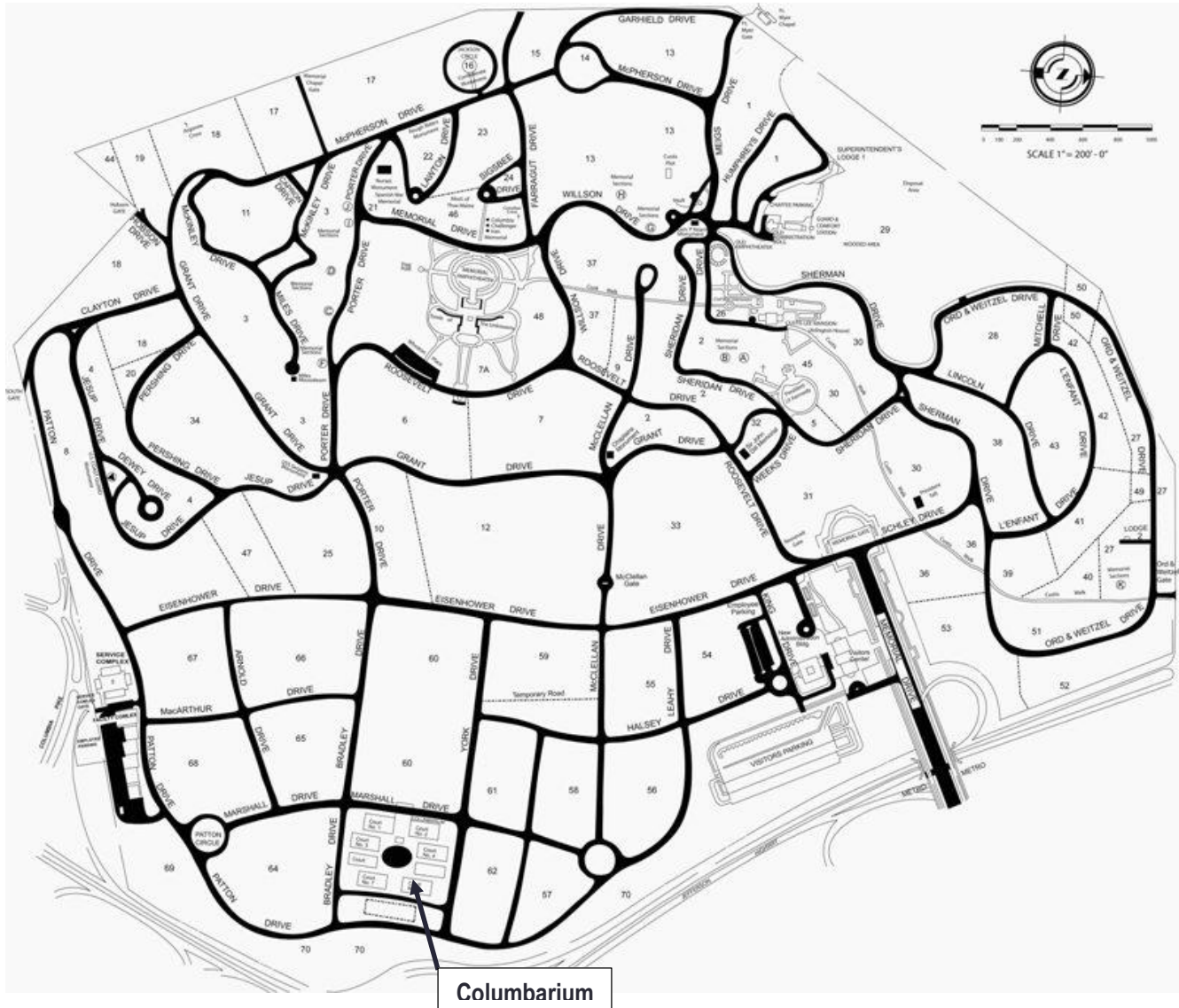

Following the ceremony, attendees are invited to lay floral arrangements at gravesites of our fallen heroes.

By metro: Metro to Arlington National Cemetery, go through Visitor Center & to the Columbarium. **By car:** Park at the Visitor Center Parking, Arlington National Cemetery (ANC) to catch shuttle at entrance. **NOTE:** The Virginia State Police will close part of Washington Boulevard near the Pentagon on Sunday, May 29, 2016, for the Rolling Thunder motorcycle rally. From 7:00 a.m. to approximately 4:00 p.m., Washington Boulevard (Route 27) will be closed from I-395 to the Memorial Bridge. There will also be no access to Arlington National Cemetery (ANC) from Washington, DC via the Memorial Bridge. ANC will only be accessible from southbound George Washington Memorial Parkway or northbound Route 110.

DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS:

South: Drive north on I-95. Near the Capital Beltway, I-95 will merge with I-495. Do NOT merge onto I-495. Continue traveling north on I-395 north toward Washington, D.C. Take exit 8-B (Arlington National Cemetery exit) to Route 27. Stay in the left lane until reaching the traffic circle (on the Virginia side of the Memorial Bridge). Bear right in the left hand lane around the traffic circle to Memorial Avenue. You will see the Arlington House on the hill ahead.

*Note: Between the hours of 6 a.m. - 9 a.m., the United States Park Police barricades the section of Memorial Circle that connects with the west bound lanes of Route 27.

North: Drive south on the Baltimore-Washington Parkway (MD - 295) or south on I-95 until you reach to the Capital Beltway (I-495). You can travel on either I-95 or on I-495. If you follow I-95, stay on the Beltway to I-395 north and then take exit 8-B (Arlington National Cemetery exit) to Route 27. Stay in the left lane until reaching the traffic circle (on the Virginia side of the Memorial Bridge). Bear right in the left hand lane around the traffic circle to Memorial Avenue. You will see the Arlington House on the hill ahead.

*Note: Between the hours of 6 a.m. - 9 a.m., the United States Park Police barricades the section of Memorial Circle that connects with the west bound lanes of Route 27.

If you follow I-495, stay on the Beltway to the George Washington Parkway. Continue on the GW Parkway and then take the Arlington Cemetery-Memorial Bridge exit. Merge left with the traffic exiting from Route 110. At the stop sign, make a left onto Memorial Avenue.

West: Follow Route 66 east to exit 73 for Lee Highway. Note: Route 66 east is HOV-2 (two or more people must be in vehicle) from 6:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., Monday through Friday. If you do not have the required number of people, follow directions noted with a star (*). Follow Lee Highway to Fort Myer Drive. Make a right on to Fort Myer Drive. Follow Fort Myer Drive, and immediately after passing over a bridge, make a left on Route 50. The two Jima Memorial will be to your right. Follow Route 50 and stay in the right hand lane. Exit onto George Washington Parkway and stay in the right hand lane. Continue on the GW Parkway and then take the Arlington Cemetery-Memorial Bridge exit. Merge left with the traffic exiting from Route 110. At the stop sign, make a left turn onto Memorial Avenue.

*Follow Route 66 east to I-495 south and exit onto Route 50 toward Arlington. Exit onto George Washington Parkway (will show as "Memorial Br/Geo Wash Pkwy"). Continue on the GW Parkway and then take the Arlington Cemetery-Memorial Bridge exit. Merge left with the traffic exiting from Route 110. At the stop sign, make a left onto Memorial Avenue.

SHUTTLE PICKUP LOCATION: Meet at the Arlington National Cemetery Visitor Center Entrance closest to the Visitor Parking Center. Volunteers with signs will direct you to the shuttle pickup location.
